Recent Legislation Passed Courtesy of Your Nebraska Hospitality Association and Our National Partners:

- **LB 274 - Alcohol to Go** – The Nebraska Hospitality Association brought forward first the Executive Order in 2020 and the permanent law was passed in May 2021. This is the first major change to alcohol legislation in Nebraska since the repeal of Prohibition.
- **LB 984 - Sales tax reimbursement, sales tax exemptions: LB 984** Sales tax reimbursement, sales tax exemptions: LB 984 – The Nebraska Hospitality Association brought forward this bill to Senator Moser who proceeded to prioritize it. The bill increased the reimbursement to business for collecting sales tax from \$75 per location per month to \$150 (3% of the first \$5000 in sales tax per month).
